



GENERAL QUESTIONS:

1. WHAT IS PUCK?

Puck is a unique and flexible alternative to slatwall, standards and grid systems.

2. WHAT SIZES ARE AVAILABLE?

Panels come in a standard size of 48" w x 96" h x 3/4" d. A Puck is a threaded aluminum disk available in 2 standard sizes: 1" or 1-1/4" diameter X 1/2" thick

3. WHAT IS THE CORE MATERIAL?

The panels use CLASS A Fire Rated MDF with NAF (No Added Formaldehyde).

4. CAN PANELS BE INSTALLED OUTDOORS?

No, Puck Panels are meant for interior use only.

FINISHES:

5. HOW MANY FINISHES ARE THERE?

A total of 7 hpl finishes are available. Matching edge banding is provided to all sides.

6. DO WE OFFER CUSTOM FINISHES?

Not at this time. However, for larger programs, custom options may be considered on a case-by-case basis.

7. DO WE OFFER CUSTOM SIZING OR PUCK SPACING?

Not at this time. However, for larger programs, custom options may be considered on a case-by-case basis.

8. DO WE OFFER SAMPLES FOR APPROVAL?

We offer 6X6 wood samples with insert, spacer, puck, and set screw

9. ARE THE PUCK PANELS EASY TO INSTALL?

All panels ship with low-profile aluminum z-clips pre-attached for easy installation.

10. WHAT IS THE WEIGHT OF EACH PANEL?

All panels are approximately 100-120 lbs.
